ASH WEDNESDAY

Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent, a 40-day period of reflection and preparation leading up to Easter. On Ash Wednesday, in some tradtions believers receive ashes on their foreheads in the shape of a cross, symbolising repentance and mortality. During Lent, many Christians practice fasting, prayer, and generosity as a way to draw closer to God and reflect on Jesus' sacrifice.

It's a time for spiritual renewal and self-discipline, culminating in the celebration of Easter and the resurrection of Jesus.

HOW SHOULD I FAST?

The spiritual discipline of fasting is about depending on God as our true source of life and sustenance.

When Jesus was on the 40th day of his fast, Satan tried to tempt Jesus to turn stones into bread.

Matt. 4:4 Jesus answered,
"It is written: 'Man shall not
live on bread alone, but on every word
that comes from the mouth of God.""

As well as fasting food, we can choose to give up something that may be a distraction from fixing our eyes on Jesus during this time, e.g. TV/Netflix, social media, video games, bad habits, negative thought patterns, etc.

With rising living costs, cut back on things you don't need. Prioritise your schedule to put God first in everything. It will not only help your budget, but will create space for you to spend time with the giver and source of all good gifts.

Fasting is not only about removing temporal things from our life but also adding good spiritual practices.

Try being extragenerous and hospitable.

SET YOURSELF APART

Restore to me the joy of your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me. Psalm 51:12 NIV

- 1. Father, grant me the strength to embrace the discipline of fasting, allowing me to become more aware of your presence and hear your voice. As I focus on you and your word, transform me into your likeness throughout this season of prayer.
- 2. May my prayers this Ash Wednesday, be centred on humility & confession, asking you to reveal my shortcomings and those things that get in the way of a deeper connection with you.
- 3. Guide me in reflecting on the significance of the 'ashes', a reminder that you alone number my days, calling me to turn away from sin, and embrace the life of the 'age to come'.
- 4. Inspire me to engage in acts of generosity, hospitality and compassion, extending kindness and support to those in need during this season.
- 5. Open my heart to a greater understanding of your kingdom will, leading me to discern and follow the path you have set before me as I embark on this journey.

PRAY FOR YOUR CHURCH

I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ.

Ephesians 3:17-18 NIV

- 1. Father God, cultivate the sense of community and connection in our church. Bless our church family and make us one as you are one. [Bless every person you know by name.]
- 2. Guide our leaders in making decisions and give them wisdom, strength and courage to follow you King Jesus.
- 3. Come Holy Spirit and fill us with a passion for worship, draw us closer to you and give us extra-ordinary joy.
- 4. Protect our church from any divisive influences and empower us to be a source of hope and light in our local community. Help us stay focused on our mission and being relevant to the needs of our community.
- 5. Bless our Vineyard church with all the resources needed for impactful ministry. Let each of us hear your call and offer our gifts, our time and money to serve you and bear much fruit.

proVISION PRAYER RETREAT
